## Good evening,

Earlier today, effective March 30th, the Chief Provincial Health Officer is limiting gatherings to no more than 10 people at indoor or outdoor place or premises. This includes places of worship, gatherings and family events such as weddings and funerals. This does not apply to a facility where health care or social services are provided including child-care centres and homeless shelters.

The Chief Provincial Health Officer has indicated there may be more recommendations coming forward early next week, including the timeline suggested for distance learning. As we stand now, we know classes will be suspended for a longer duration, so we have been focusing on the process of long term planning for distance/remote learning to occur. The Minister of Education is waiting for the recommendation from the Chief Provincial Health Officer before any further announcements.

Next week is Spring Break, so the teachers will not be assigning any more assignments or requiring any video chats, etc. Next week is a week to enjoy with the family and do some outdoor activities. On Monday, April 6th, teachers will be back at work and ready to do distance learning with your child(ren). Please keep in contact with

your teacher(s) in regards to work load and/or challenges. We know every home situation is different and are trying to meet as many needs as possible. Do not struggle, but talk to you teacher and he/she can help problem solve.
