### SALT DOUGH HANDPRINTS

**You will need:**

- 1 cup salt
- 1 cup flour
- Warm water



**What to do:**

1. Combine 1 cup salt and 1 cup flour. Stir 1/2 cup warm water in slowly. When combined, should be about the consistency of play dough. Add a little more water if dry, or a little more flour if wet.
2. Once combined roll a ball and flatten until about 1/4-1/2 inch thick. Press your child's hand into the center. Don't worry if you mess up, just roll the ball up and start again. Once you have a print, make a hole near the top. Carefully turn over and write any information such as your child's name or the date into the dough on the back. Allow to dry for at least 24 hours.
3. After 24 hours of allowing the handprint to dry, you could paint the handprint or just leave it the natural white that it was made in.
4. After the paint dries, hang with ribbon.
