My Learning at Home

Conversations around natural curiosities and learning through play are great opportunities for children. Please know that although the "school time" is likely reduced at home, children will continue to learn.

Please keep your child(ren)'s teacher(s) as part of the conversation if you have any questions about the curriculum being delivered remotely. The teachers are able to adapt a child's workload as required. We are currently trying to incorporate online, paper and pencil tasks, and projects into the learning experiences. We realize that very few parents are trained educators, and we are here to support you in any way we can to help you and your child(ren). We are in this together to support one another in ways we couldn't have imagined before.

Your child(ren)'s work will be assessed by their teacher(s) in the coming months and a final report card will be completed in June.

Although the school building is closed, we believe this remote curriculum based learning is vital in helping ensure the students continue to develop and are prepared for the return of in-class learning.
