

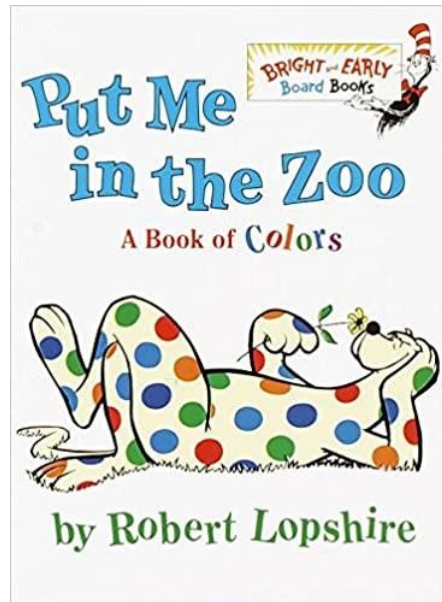

PUT ME IN THE ZOO PAPER PLATE ACTIVITY

YOU WILL NEED:

- Paper plate
- Yellow paint
- Paint brush
- Large googly eyes

- Pom poms (assorted colours)
- Black marker
- Yellow construction paper
- Glue
- Scissors

WHAT TO DO:

1. Paint the paper plate with the yellow paint.
2. After the paint dries, glue on the large googly eyes and black pom-pom for the nose.
3. Draw a “w” shape for the mouth.
4. Glue the other pom-poms all over the paper plate for the spots.
5. Cut circles out of the yellow construction paper. If your child is just learning how to use scissors, trace the circles on the paper and help your child cut by placing your hand over his or her hand.
6. Glue on the yellow circle for the ears.
