This week I will be providing you with ideas and suggestions for an alphabet theme.

Writing in shaving cream

To start this writing activity, grab a cookie sheet, and spread shaving cream on top. Using your finger, form the letter you want to teach your child in the shaving cream. Have your child trace over the letter you just wrote.



2. **Writing in Sand** – Sand makes a perfect writing surface. Pour a little water on the sand and smooth it with your hand or the back of a toy shovel. Use a stick as a writing tool. (If you can't find one, fingers will work too!)



Each activity will help your children strengthen their letter recognition and develop fine motor skills.
