- 1. Board Report David Kuik
  - New Build Construction
    - No Construction has started yet it should have started in July, however the application is waiting approval with the City of Winnipeg. There are a number of city departments that need to say 'yes' to changing the current zoning and are scheduled to look at this week.
    - Once zoning is approved then financing can be completed by the bank and permits are completed. Likely won't be done in September.
    - Is there a hard date for no building? No construction is able to occur during the winter.
    - Will this delay the grades applying to the school? The expansion will only impact Grade 11 & 12 who require science labs, however will first move the labs to second semester so there is less impact, and have alternate schools as options or a mobile lab.
    - PIP Proposal was denied. The main group focus is to guide/direct the school, and want it to remain as fundraising endeavours.

- New staff are off to a great start and are a good fit for the school.

  - October 18 Missions Fundraiser \$40.00/ticket, with a dessert auction, tables will compete for which dessert to eat at the event. In need of 13-14 desserts. The funds raised are for the actual missions portion of the trip, each Student are doing their own fundraising and paying their own way.
